ANNOUNCING WISCAR'S PIONEER EXECUTIVE SECRETARY





Below are highlights of the events and the key lessons that we will continue to take forward.

CENTER FOR PUBLIC POLICY ALTERNATIVES NIGERIA(CPPA)/ CANADA'S INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT RESEARCH CENTER (IDDRC)

n Thursday March 29th 2018, Mrs. Oyagbola presented a keynote paper on the topic "A Rising Tide Raises all Boats: Does Empowering the Woman raise Economic Growth?". TWI - THE CIRCLE FORUM





t The Women's International Event "The Circle", Mrs. Oyagbola spoke on the issue "WHAT DO WOMEN IN NIGERIA LACK; NEEDS, WANTS, SOLUTIONS, AND ACTIONS". She discussed this with other panelists including former Minister of the Federal Republic of Nigeria Dr. Mrs Kema Chikwe, Mrs. Clare Omatseye CEO JNC International and 2019 Presidential aspirant Dr. Kingsley Moghalu. They reached a consensus on the importance of ensuring that the Gender and Equal Opportunities Bill, rejected by the National Assembly in 2016 is passed and becomes Law as soon as possible.

RISE UP ADVOCACY ACCELERATOR





s a learning organization, WISCAR believes in the upskilling of its staff and community, to ensure that they are able to deliver on our commitment for impact. WISCAR Executive Secretary participated in a weeklong Leadership Accelerator Workshop on results based advocacy and leadership from 16th to 22nd of April 2018. She was selected to attend the workshop along with 19 other nonprofits facilitated by RISE UP for Women and Girls an International Non-Governmental Organization in partnership with Cummins. As part of the RISE UP community, WISCAR will now be eligible to access resources and funding opportunities as they arise.
